

Carparking

Ensuring the safety of our students is paramount, especially during drop-off and pick-up times. Please adhere to car park signage when parking. However, we kindly request that you observe the "no parking" and "no standing" signs on the bush side of VIctoria Street. Parking on this side of the road obstructs visibility and poses risks to students crossing the road and entering other parked cars.

Closed Turning Circle Gates

As our students readjust to school routines after the holiday break, there may be occasions when we close the turning circle gates to prevent students from leaving the school grounds. Please note that during these times, the gates will not be locked, and access to the school will remain available.
